



## TERMS OF REFERENCE MEDICAL COMPENSATION REVIEW COMMITTEE

### Statutory Context

The Medical Compensation Review Committee is effectively a joint committee with the Minister of Health established by *The Medical Care Insurance Act*. The provisions below apply to the SMA appointees.

### Composition

1. The Act provides that the Board of Directors and the Minister shall each appoint up to six representatives to the Committee.
2. The S.M.A. appointees shall include:
  - (a) practitioners,
  - (b) the SMA appointed bargaining consultant(s), and
  - (c) member(s) of the secretariat.

### Functions

The Act specifies that the purpose of the Committee is to prepare an agreement to revise the rates in the Payment Schedule.

### Minutes

1. Minutes of the meetings of the Committee shall be distributed to the:
  - (a) Economics Committee,
  - (b) Tariff Committee,
  - (c) Payment Schedule Review Committee,
  - (d) Intersectional Council,
  - (e) Board of Directors.
2. The Committee shall receive the minutes of the meetings of the Committees listed in 1(a) to 1(d) as well as all the information letters sent to those Committees.
